

Complete Streets Prioritization Plan and Survey Update-

Member Bloomfield shared the following survey results.

Main Street from Dover Street to Cross Street (Scituate Town line) – 1.7 miles 506 votes

Old Oaken Bucket- Central Street to Cross Street (includes the Vinal School) - 0.8 miles 501 votes

Jacobs Lane from Main Street to Jacobs Pond Parking Lot – 0.3 miles **225 votes**

Member Cafferty would like to see the committee pursue the two with the most votes.

Aura Hagerty, 59 May Elm Road, asked for background on committee.

Member Bloomfield shared in 2016 a Prioritization Plan was created and the first few items on the plan are mostly complete therefore a new revised plan will be designed around the new survey that was just completed.

Member Fergusson will walk both locations before the next meeting to determine what would be needed to move forward on each location. Easements, estimates to complete and challenges for each project will be discussed at the next meeting.
