Open Space & Recreation Plan (OSRP) Implementation Committee

Meeting Minutes Wednesday, July 26, 2023 at 5:00 pm in person and via Zoom

The meeting was called to order by Wahl at 5:02 pm.

Ms. Wahl announced that all votes will be roll call votes as some of the meeting participants are using remote access software. The meeting is being recorded and the audio file will be available upon request. It was noted that this meeting will be conducted pursuant to the Executive Order dated March 12, 2020 suspending certain provisions of the Open meeting Law, Gen. L. c. 30A §20 et seq. and 940 CMR 29.01 et seq extended to March 31, 2025.

The **agenda** was accepted as written. (Bawabe motioned, Saunders seconded, all in favor)

The **minutes** for the June 7, 2023 meeting were approved as written. (*Minihane motioned*, *Quirk seconded*, *all in favor*)

The plans for **Conservation Day on August 19**th were discussed. The event will be from 9:00-1:00 at the Jacobs Pond conservation area. The events for the day are:

- Flora & Fauna walk with Brian Taylor (NSRWA)

- Touch-A-Truck with Norwell Police & Fire Departments

Also on August 19th will be the **Stetson Heritage Day celebration** at the Stetson Kindred pavilion on the North River (83 Stetson Shrine Road) from 1:00-4:00. This event is co-sponsored by the Norwell Historical Society and the Stetson Kindred of America, and the events include:

- A talk about the Stetson spring and the history of water use in Norwell by Steve Ivas
- A Conservation-led trail walk by Will Saunders

The discussion on **Beech Leaf Disease** that took place during the last meeting was continued. Bawabe spoke to Abraham Monahan from Bartlett Tree Experts, and he noted that Bartlett did a trial of possible treatments for the nematode and resulting Beech Leaf Disease last year and they were effective. Bawabe will contact him to see if Bartlett would be willing to do a pilot program with the Town of Norwell. In the meantime, Saunders will identify particularly important Beech trees that should be saved.
