

Member Cafferty would like to move forward with a Request for Proposals (RFP) since the project was approved at the May 2023 Town Meeting. Member Cafferty asked that Ilana Quirk work on pulling together the scope of work for the RFP. Member Cafferty believes to start with a broad range of requests including all possibilities is the proper way to gauge what is doable, for how much money and then proceed according to the results. Member Cafferty stated he normally includes cost options, an abbreviation notice of resource area delineation (ANRAD) a drawing, bid documents and advertise. Member Cafferty states when you take this approach you can prepare accordingly financially, and scale back as needed. Ilana Quirk will work on getting the document prepared so the Conservation Commission can review and offer thoughts and recommendations too over the next month.
